EFFECTIVE 2011, SAN MATEO COUNTY HEALTH REQUIRES ALL PRACTITIONERS TO PRE-REGISTER WITH THE DEPARTMENT DIRECTLY - www.smhealth.org/environ/bodyart NO EXCEPTIONS.

MOVE-IN TIME FRI. 8:30am – 1pm (Loading door will close at 1pm)

SHOW HOURS FRI. 2pm-11pm, SAT. 11am-11pm, SUN. 11am-8pm (Stop work 1 hr before closing)
MOVE-OUT TIME SUN. 8pm – 9:30pm No early move out. \$100/hour late charge after 9:30pm.

BOOTH PACKAGE A 10'x10' (or 8'x10' at management's discretion) booth to include:
1 skirted table, 1 plain table, 3 chairs, 1 ID sign, 2 trashcans, 5-amp electricity, and 3 wristbands. Additional or replacement wristband costs \$35 each.

WRISTBAND We do not allow sharing or selling of wristbands. You will lose your wristband if it is cut, taped, or tempered with in any way. Only wear your wristband on your wrist. Our staff will replace any and all loose but valid wristbands.

WHAT TO BRING Electrical cords, surge protectors, extra tables, chairs, table clothes, etc.

FOOD VENDORS All food or beverage vendors must be pre-approved. Food samplings must be less than 1 ounce and be pre-approved. A fee may be imposed by the show facility.

SELLER'S PERMIT Per state regulations, anyone selling merchandise must have a valid State's seller's permit. Failure to do so will be subject to removal from show. Bring a copy of your permit to the show.

MUSIC No music louder than 85 decibels allowed. Violators will be ejected on 2nd violation.

HEALTH DEPT. REQUIREMENTS Health department regulations governing all tattooing/piercing shops:

- 1) EACH ARTIST MUST HAVE A CURRENT BLOOD BORNE PATHOGEN TRAINING CERTIFICATE
- 2) EACH ARTIST MUST CARRY A PHOTO ID
- 3) EACH TATTOOING/PIERCING BOOTH MUST HAVE:
 - a. A WRITTEN EXPOSURE CONTROL PLAN
 - b. AFTER CARE FORMS FOR CLIENTS
 - c. CLIENT RELEASE FORMS AND CLIENTS LOG SHEETS – Submit log sheets to promoter after event
- 4) NO FOOD OR DRINKS ALLOWED INSIDE BOOTH AT ALL TIMES
- 5) NO ONE UNDER 18 SHALL BE ALLOWED IN A BODY ART WORKSTATION FOR ANY KIND OF TATTOOING.
- 6) NO ONE UNDER 16 SHALL BE ALLOWED TO GET PIERCINGS. MINORS ABOVE 16 MAY GET BODY PIERCINGS IF ACCOMPANIED BY AND HAVE WRITTEN CONSENT BY THE PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN.
- 7) CLIENT CHAIR/TABLE MUST BE WIPE DOWN WITH AN EPA REGISTERED DISINFECTANT USING A SINGLE-USE PAPER TOWEL BEFORE AND AFTER EACH CLIENT.
- 8) ALL USED NEEDLES MUST BE DEPOSED OF INTO APPROVED SHARPS CONTAINERS.
- 9) ALL TATTOOING/PIERCING EQUIPMENT MUST BE STERILIZED. STERILIZATION STATION AVAILABLE ON-SITE.

TEMPORARY HEALTH PERMIT Some counties require tattooing/piercing shops to obtain temporary health permits to in order to operate at a show. Ask your sales rep for details.

BLOOD BORNE PATHOGENS TRAINING & CERTIFICATE On-site training available at Noon Friday. Annual training certificate required from each tattooing/piercing artist. Bring a copy to the show for inspection.

BUSINESS LICENSE Bring a copy of your business license and all related permits to the show for inspection.

INDUSTRY PRICING Offer your service at industry standard minimum prices such as \$30 for piercing, \$60 tattooing.

TATTOO KITS Do not sell tattooing kits/equipment to non-industry/non-certified customers.
